

Parent's Code of Conduct

You are expected to conduct yourself in a way that will enhance your child's experiences. Your interaction with other parents, players, and coaches is extremely important and should be viewed as a priority to establishing a positive learning environment. The following are guidelines we as of each parent.

1. While attending practices and games, be supportive of the coaches, officials and administrative staff running these events.
2. Get to know each player, parent, and coach associated with your team. Support the efforts they make by getting involved and offering assistance and encouragement throughout the season. Also, encourage your child to support their efforts as well.
3. Refrain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, and vulgar and profane language at all events.
4. During games, be positive towards the game effort of each player, coach, and official regardless of score and outcome.
5. Never approach coaches or officials in a physical, violent, or abusive manner. Always address issues in a mature manner by scheduling a meeting or discussing the issue in private.
